Our friends in Israel wanted me to express to you how much they appreciate your generosity. In the Land

Last time I wrote to you, I told how I arrived in Israel five days before

After the ten days, I stayed on another three. All together, I was in Eretz Yisrael just under three weeks.

Following the direction of The Ruach HaKodesh (Holy Spirit), I started the trip in the Tel Aviv and Ashdod, Israel areas. I had evangelism opportunities and visited good friends, including two Pastors and one evangelist that **MJMI** partially supports. It is so great to stay in the homes of these sold-out-to-Yeshua, totally committed friends that I see on each of my trips. Opportunities to encourage, build up, and hear the great progress that is being made from our associates in Israel (half

way around the world) is always my favorite part of each Israel trip.

The team then had ministry opportunities at Messianic Jewish Congregations in Jaffa and Haifa.

From Haifa we went to Jerusalem. We spent a day sightseeing in the old city of Jerusalem; including the



Western Wall and other antiquities. Just outside of Jerusalem the team had the opportunity to minister to a group of young people called, “Revive-Israel.” This group of approximately 20 young people were super open to our ministering and teaching. One of the people involved with this group is one of our **MJMI** friends in Israel who we partially support. After spending numbers of hours: in prayer, worship, teaching and hands on ministry, the Ruach HaKodesh manifested in many ways, including prophecy, healing and encouragement.

Next and last for this newsletter was the ministry by our team in Ashdod at Congregation Beit Hallel. Israel P. is the Pastor of this congregation (who we have been partially supporting for eight years) and Aviel, who is a **MJMI** friend in Israel that we have been partially
