If you have been thinking you lost your January 2009 **MJMI** newsletter, you didn't. This February 2009 is the first newsletter for 2009. As most of you know, we have

I want to take this time to thank you for being partners with **MJMI** in many ways. By your prayers and financial giving, you have helped to make possible all the good things Adonai has done through **MJMI**, and hopefully will continue to do so.

I know that many of you are going through tough times; with losing jobs, prices of gasoline and groceries rising. Yet you give and pray for our Jewish Israeli brothers and sisters and put yourself last. This is how Yeshua taught

us to live. I am now going to share some testimonies of my fiends and your evangelistic workers in Israel.

The Work of Evangelism

As I am seeking these new workers, I need your prayers. Our hope is to support one worker in three key cities—Jerusalem, Haifa, and Tel Aviv. Please ask the Lord to lead me to people he has chosen to fill these positions. This work is different than anything we have done in the past—we are definitely breaking new ground!

One of the differences in this work is our desire to reach all Israelis, whether native born or new immigrants. The Land of Israel is full of turmoil and conflict at this time. People from all walks of life are seeking answers, and we want to be available to help them.

In the past, we have talked a great deal about sharing the Good News with new immigrants while helping them through the Aliyah process. Our Aliyah efforts will continue! We still need your support to help needy Jewish families in the Former Soviet Union make the journey to their promised homeland. It doesn't take a huge amount of money to support this effort—only \$300 allows one person to make Aliyah. Please pray about giving towards this ongoing work!
