I want all of you to hear these positive things of what The Lord is doing at this time when most of what you hear, whether it be about America, Israel, or about our economy, is less than positive. Praise our God for His faithfulness and thanks to all of you who continue to stand with us financially and in prayer.

As you have read in the September and October newsletters, my trip to Israel this

summer, was the best yet. I have told you about our work in feeding the poor in Ashdod. Also, the partnership we have in providing products from Israel with our friends in the Galilee area, that you can access through our web site. Additionally, in these newsletters, I have showed you some of the people we partially support who are being used mightily by our God, through His Holy Spirit (Ruach HaKodesh) to help Israeli Jewish people come to know Jesus (Yeshua), as their Messiah, personal Lord and Savior/Redeemer. Lastly, I have spoken about our focus on Aliyah (Jewish People moving from wherever they live now, to Israel), especially from the West. You will be hearing more and more about this from MJMI, and if you get information from any Israeli or Jewish sources. This time is critical in the moving of the Spirit of God in His Special

Land. We will talk more, soon about the “Aliyah Highway” that we are putting a great deal of energy, time and effort towards.

This month I want to teach a little, based on what The Lord has been doing in my life, and I suspect is doing with many of you, or will be doing with you.

Walking in Power

stance. I am talking in terms of our daily walk while we are still here on planet earth as things are now. Certainly a personal relationship with Yeshua has to come first to the end of Salvation. However, if you have had a salvation experience, and never walked in the Power of the Ruach HaKodesh, I would like to ask—How is that working out for you?

You will see on our Reply card this time, a book I am recommending to you—whether you get it through us on the MJMI web site, or go to Amazon, or eBay or to the publisher—which is entitled “Forgotten God” and subtitled “Reversing Our Tragic Neglect of The Holy Spirit”, by Francis Chan. This book has changed my life greatly in the last six months; I hope it does for you too.

A great deal of the Messianic Jewish Congregations, that I have experienced, seem to have a good knowledge of The Word of God, but not the Power of God. To be a full participant of the Kingdom of God, NOW, we need both, in our lives. We find in the New Covenant Scriptures (B’rit Chadasha) that the newly-formed Messianic Jewish Movement, with no small measure of vulnerability, depended upon the Ruach HaKodesh (The Holy Spirit) to hold the Believers together, and to lead them into leadership. Today, in the re-birthed modern Messianic Jewish Movement we are totally dependent upon Adonai’s Ruach. It is how we got here, how we will move forward, how we will succeed, and how we will fulfill Adonai’s purpose in bringing His Chosen People back to His Messiah, Yeshua. If we turn away from our spiritual and prophetic roots, it should not surprise us if we shrivel up and die as a movement. The Scriptures are clear that we are in a spiritual battle with the forces of darkness. This warfare cannot be fought with human weapons of talents,
