Shalom, my friends,

The three fall feasts are...

- **Rosh Hashanah (Feast of Trumpets)**, this year on September 29 (all feasts begin at sundown the night previous)
- **Yom Kippur (Day of Atonement)**, this year on October 8, and
- **Sukkoth (Tabernacles)**, this year on October 13-19.

These days are of immense importance to those of us who believe that Yeshua is the Messiah of Israel and the Redeemer of all the nations.

Since **Yeshua fulfilled the Spring feasts**—he was executed at **Passover**, rose three days later on the day of the first **wave offering**, and poured His Spirit into the hearts of believers for the first time on **Pentecost**—we live expectantly when these fall holidays approach.

Rosh Hashanah is the time to blow the shofar, a call to attention, time to prepare for battle. Yom Kippur is the day for introspection, repentance, judgment. **Sukkoth** is the time we sit together under the umbrella of God's protection.

In recent years, the Lord has been blowing resounding trumpets on Rosh Hashanah. Three years ago on Rosh Hashanah, the first day of the 7th month, the month of Tishrei, the US stock market fell 777.7 points. 7th month, 777.7 point drop. During the next ten days, the "**Days of Awe**" leading up to **Yom Kippur**, there were two more major market drops. "Wake up!" the Lord seemed to be saying to those with listening ears.



Ten years ago during the Ten Days of Awe between Rosh Hashanah and

Yom Kippur, in **September 2001**, the Lord blew the strongest Shofar in US history when the World Trade Center towers were destroyed.

As we approach the holidays this year, Israel's surrounding neighbors are threatening her very existence, and the threat of terrorism hangs over the whole world. **This is the time for God's people to rise up with increased worship and intercession!**

From the sounding of the shofar on Rosh Hashanah (photo below), to the days of great rejoicing during Sukkot (photo right), this season is filled with many beautiful pictures of our soon-returning Messiah. As Jewish people throughout the world are taking part in these special times, let us lift our voices to heaven, praying that the Lord will open their eyes to see Yeshua, their Messiah—the Lamb of God who alone can take away the sins of the world!



Let us pray that we, the people of God, the believers in Yeshua worldwide, will open our hearts to receive the fullness of His message during this season, and that God will put His hand of protection around His

people. For the King and for His Kingdom!

The Harvest Continues


